



Rev. Micah Jackson

Rev. Jackson is a native of Richmond, VA and the eldest of three children. He is married to the Rev. Cee Cee Jackson and together they are the parents of two children, Aaron and Melanie.

Rev. Jackson was raised and matured under the spiritual guidance of the Mt.
